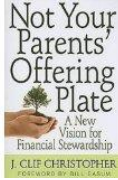


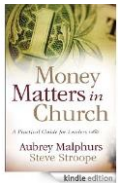

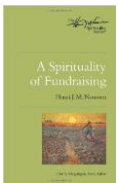
Not your parents' offering plate – J. Clif Christopher.
